TriBeta General Information

- Chapter Announcements sent beginning of Fall & Spring semesters.
 - https://www.tribeta.org/announcements
- ► Chapter Forms & Files One-stop resource for important forms and files
 - https://www.tribeta.org/forms-files
- Can induct members at any time.
 - Some chapters do twice per year, Fall and Spring.
 - Others elect for only once per year, typically Spring.
 - ▶ Others invite new members in Fall and have 1 induction ceremony for Fall & Spring members once per year.
- ► All memberships are processed through My Honor Society.
 - ▶ Chapters no longer collect the one-time national membership dues.
 - ▶ Students will pay their dues online through the email invitation they receive.

Chapter Advisor Role/Responsibilities

- Provide continuity within the chapter as members graduate to keep chapter active
- ► Help foster a sense of community and belonging among chapter members
- ▶ Provide structure, oversight at chapter events and meetings
- Help recruit new members and verify students meet member eligibility requirements
- Use My Honor Society platform to invite all eligible students to join
- ▶ Receive membership materials and give new members their materials
- ► Encourage research with the members, be excited about Biology, offer mentorship
- Communicate with the national office at least once per academic year

Fall Semester - Things to Know

- Research Grant Applications
 - Every Fall, posted by Sept 1
 - Deadline to apply Sept 30
 - Regular or promoted members are eligible to apply for funding
 - ► Funding notifications sent mid-October
 - Grant checks mail out by early November

- Bertholf Award Applications
 - Application to be considered for the Outstanding Chapter of the Year
 - ► Posted in Fall, mid Sept
 - Deadline to apply Nov 1
 - ► Cover the previous academic year chapter/member activities

Spring Semester - Things to Know

- District Convention Travel Grant Applications
 - Every Spring (Started Spring 2023) posted/emailed by February 1
 - Deadline to apply February 28
 - Research Grant recipients from prior Fall eligible to apply
- District/Regional TriBeta Conventions
 - Every Spring held across 12 district/regional conventions
 - ► Hosted by TriBeta chapters at their campuses for most
 - Opportunity for research grant recipients to present their research to meet the funding requirements
 - Any TriBeta member can present at the conventions
 - ► Eligible for oral and poster presentation awards with up to \$900 in travel reimbursement to attend the next national convention for 1st place recipients
 - ► Frank G. Brooks Award Oral Presentation
 - ▶ John C. Johnson Award Poster Presentation

Ways to Grow Membership



 - Overview of benefits, eligibility requirements, and fees by type.
- Associate Level of Membership
 - ▶ Pull list of all registered students enrolled in biology courses for that term and upload to the invitation group.
 - Anyone with an interest in life sciences can join regardless of declared major, their academic year, GPA, or courses taken.
 - ► Example: 777 students invited all enrolled in BIO classes last Fall. 10% acceptance rate and the chapter had 77 new members who will be with the chapter for 2-3 years.
- ► Regular membership includes more than strictly "Biology" majors
 - ► Majors that are allowed, but not limited to, include Biochemistry, Ecology, Environmental Science, Microbiology, Cell Biology and Neuroscience majors, as long as the specific institution requires sufficient biology courses within that focus of study. Health Science majors may be considered, depending upon the biology emphasis at an institution.
